WORKFORCE AND TRAINING

- Partnered with Bilingual America on an innovative leadership training program for companies with Latino workers to address the industry's labor challenges
- Funding for NRCA's Pro Certification
 Series to help attract and keep workers and enhance the professionalism of the roofing industry

TECHNOLOGY/RESEARCH

- Committed more than \$16,000 to update NRCA's EnergyWise Online Calculator to include new energy and green construction codes making it current through 2017
- Funded the development of data necessary to substantiate compliance of nonadhered roof systems (e.g. seam-fastened, mechanically attached single-ply member roof systems) with requirements of the International Energy Conservation Code, 2012 edition
- Supported development of the Wall of Wind at Florida International University to more accurately predict roof system performance in high-wind conditions

ADVANCING EDUCATION

- Partnered with top U.S. construction management schools to incorporate
 roofing-specific curriculum into undergraduate programs, provide student
 and faculty scholarships, and create internship programs to expose students to
 careers in roofing.
- Sponsored a Construction Management Student Design Competition to promote careers in roofing industry management.
- Distributed \$55,000 in scholarships through the Melvin Kruger Endowed Scholarship Program in 2017 and \$735,000 in scholarship funds to 122 students since the program's inception in 1986.
