•Outstanding on-the-job performance

Because the roof deck was not strong enough to hold machine skid loaders, John's crew utilized small four-wheelers with lightweight carts to move huge amount of debris across the vast roof areas. This creative solution saved John and his team precious time. When the project was complete the roofing manufacturer's final inspection found only two very minor items requiring address, which were corrected by John in a mere 10 minutes. The roof installation met the manufacturer's strict standards of quality and their best warranty was issued.

In addition, they attached insulation and a permanent TPO membrane over a 105,000 sq. ft. area. In just two weeks, the arena was watertight and ready for the Rodeo.
